(CTE) Courses and Assignments

New CTE Assignments – In compliance with HB 3485, the SBOE approved new CTE courses, including courses that would satisfy the fourth year of mathematics or science credit for the recommended or distinguished graduation plans.

New CTE courses will be implemented in fall 2010. The targeted effective date is August 19, 2010.
